RETREAT IDEAS FOR LENT

Lent is a good time to do some deep introspection about our relationship to God. It is wise to do this in prayer and without distractions. Do you need a place to go to be in retreat? The following are some suggestions not too far from home:

OUTDOORS:

- ♥ Osage State Park 12 miles west of Bartlesville on Hwy 60. The park offers many spots for sitting and reflecting, walking, and just being. It is far enough out of town to leave obligations behind for the day. Should you wish to be there overnight, contact the Ranger station about cabins. 918-336-4141.
- ♣ Hulah Dam, southwest end. There is a lovely, newish sitting and viewing area with multiple benches. The restrooms are new and clean. Approach on Hwy 10 from the west. Cell service is spotty, which is a plus for a retreat. Day-long or overnight:
- ₱ St. Joseph's Monastery in Tulsa, run by Benedictine sisters. Small rooms for overnight, some spiritual direction, meals, and some prayer times are available. The charge is minimal. Call 918-746-4223 for additional information. The monastery is located at 21st and Harvard.
- ♥ Osage Forest of Peace, 5 miles west of Sand Springs. This is truly a retreat center, with individual cabins available. Meals are also available, trained spiritual directors are on site. Call 918-245-2734.
- **♦ St. Crispin's**, the Episcopal Conference and Retreat Center does individual retreats. St. Crispin's is located in Wewoka, about 2½ hours southwest of Bartlesville. There are no spiritual directors on site. 405-382-1619.

INDOOR SHORT RETREATS:

This church has multiple rooms available during the weekdays and in the evenings until 10:30 p. m. Call the church office to check on any room availability. The library and the deacon's den are recommended for getting away from the daily noise of the church. Your priest is available by appointment for guidance and/or confession. 918-336-1212.

Thoughts from Fr. Sean



Recently I was invited to attend The Episcopal Church's Preaching for Excellence Program, to be held in New Jersey in June. They have asked that the thirty of us—all Episcopal priests from around the nation—submit a written sermon on the topic of 'forgiveness' to be analyzed, critiqued and commented upon. As I was writing that sermon, my thoughts started wandering to another thought: Does everyone critique sermons, and do you have to be a

preacher to give a sermon? It turns out that what we say—all of us Christians—and how we say it, matters. I was grateful to be reminded of this just the other day when someone gently reminded me that in town, on Facebook and everywhere I go, I represent part of the face of St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Therefore, everything said and every conversation is considered one that represents the Christian faith.

How am I doing? But even bigger still, how are YOU doing? In our everyday lives, how are people receiving the words and stories we tell, the thoughts and memes we post? I wonder if everyone 'gets' our humor or agrees with our opinions? I also wonder whether or not our 'humor' is really funny, at all. It may be time for all of us to be reminded gently that we are not only the hands and feet of Christ, but also the mouths that have been given the responsibility of speaking God's love to everyone in the world. Are we doing that? In the daily sermonettes of our lives, the coffee talk banter and Facebook posting, can we see Christ in our words and writing? I hope that you, too, can be willing to look into the mirror when someone holds it up to your face and see that there is always room for growth and barely any, if at all, room for humor or judgment at the expense of others. I hope that you (as I hope that I) can be intentional in the way we speak to each other, in the way we discuss the difficult things, so that we can all stand firm in our calling to spread the good news of Jesus Christ. Let's keep one another accountable to that as we sojourn on through Lent.
