Our approach was to have a conversation with the candidates. We asked questions to learn more about them and they asked questions to learn more about St. Luke's. Most sessions lasted about an hour.

We found last week's candidate conversations to be very productive.

We have interviews scheduled with other candidates in the coming weeks.

After we complete the interview phase, we will assess the candidate's fit with the needs of St. Luke's. The next phase of our rector search process will be site visits to the candidate's parish and home.
