Presiding Bishop Curry's opening address is not to be missed. Listen to it here at episcopalchurch.org under "Opening Sermon--The Way of Love."

A resolution to revise the Book of Common Prayer has passed.
The revision is expected to be complete in 2020.

On Sunday, many of the convention goers, including the Presiding Bishop, gathered in public witness outside the Hutto Detention Facility in rural Texas, where immigrant women are being detained separately from their children. You will be hearing more about Bishop Curry's rule of life for us.
