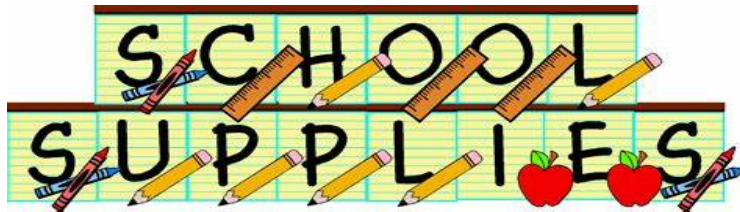
SAVE THE DATE – OCTOBER 7TH
