The hospital will not let us know that you are there—it is a violation of federal law. So, text me or call me at **918.330.6108** or let Robyn know by calling 918.336.1212. Also, there are a few steps before you can leave a message on the parish answering system, so please wait. Our answering system is a bit antiquated, and Robyn is working on a way to shorten the process to leave a message.
- 2. Pastoral care at St. Luke's is a shared ministry between the priests, deacons, and laity. Please contact one of the members of the clergy or the parish secretary directly if you have any pastoral need. We cannot respond if we don't know there is an issue.
- 3. Respect each other's privacy. There may be a good reason why someone might not want a member of the clergy or members of the parish to know about an illness or other personal issue. Please ask permission from the person before you share another's story or before you request a pastoral visit for someone else. In the case of a life-threatening emergency, use common sense.
- 4. If you are interested in serving as part of the parish's pastoral care team, please contact me or Deacon Lauri.
