St. Luke's Church – The First 100 Years

Ever wonder how St. Luke's came to be or what it was like to be a member of St. Luke's in the twentieth century? We wondered also and so, to celebrate the centennial of St. Luke's life as a parish, the Young Disciples researched and

produced a DVD to tell the story of those first 100 years. Here's a sampling of what you'll see and learn about:

- How the church was started by lay people
- Construction photos of the present "stone church"
- "Valley View Lodge" was a place east of Sunset Lake that was jointly owned by St. Luke's and a parish in Pawhuska.
- Sunday School was taught by teenagers in the late 1930's and early 1940's
- Rodgers Hall was constructed on the site of original rectory in the early 1940's
- The "little white church" was moved across town to make way for the construction of today's "stone church"
- The many musical presentations put on by youth and adults
- The special outreach to help families who came to Bartlesville after Hurricane Katrina
- Unique perspectives on God from the viewpoint of our youth
- "Lunch Stop" program to help feed folks every day at noon
- Mission trips to El Paso
- Kane Reading Mentor program
- All the clergy who served St. Luke's
