## **The Least of These**

**Matthew 25:34-40**

**Jesus said, "Then the king will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?' And the king will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.'"**

We have chosen to observe Lent together around this part of Matthew 25. Each Wednesday evening will find us gathering together for a 3-part opportunity to grow in grace and service. From 5:15-5:45 we will participate in the Holy Eucharist. The meditations will be based on this scripture from Matthew.

From 5:45-6:15, we will enjoy the fellowship of a simple soup supper. The menu will just be soup, bread, and something to drink.

From 6:15-7:15, we will hear from several different ministries in the area, relating to this verse in Matthew. For example, we hope to hear from the ministry of the tiny houses off Adams. The presentations will center around two questions for our presenters--what need is being met by this program and what do you need from us--as a church and as individuals. There is planned time for questions and discussion. More information on each presentation will be available next week.

Please plan to make Wednesday evenings a part of your Lenten discipline. We invite you to come for all of the evening, or part of it as your schedule allows. Please feel free to bring friends who might be interested in the topic. Watch future newsletters for developing plans.
