To help encourage singing, the organ preludes during Lent will be based on a specific hymn tune that will also be included in hymns for congregations sing on that Sunday. The service bulletin will give information so you can look in *The Hymnal* to find the hymn being featured in the prelude and use the hymn text as a meditation.

Something different beginning this Sunday will be music for the Kyrie, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei. These will be printed on card stock in the pew racks for ease in finding them. You will be asked to leave these in the pew racks for use during the Sundays in Lent.
