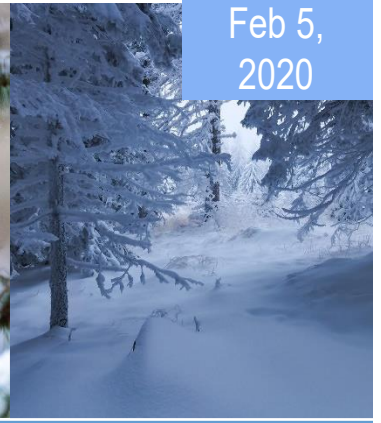

Annual Meeting Roundup

The Annual Meeting is over and the new vestry and other officers have been elected. Governance of the church is an important responsibility, and I appreciate the work of the nominating committee and its chairperson, Jo Baughman, for presenting the parish with a strong slate of nominees to lead us into the future. I'm always a little anxious that members will be reluctant to serve, yet, once again, the members stepped up and agreed to serve when asked.

I think its important to recognize our vestry members whose terms have expired. Miriam Petrovich, Scott Peterson, and Kelli Bradshaw have been exceptional parish leaders during their terms on the vestry. All have been active and engaged in vestry activities and each have offered their own special gifts and insights to the work of the vestry. I hope members of the parish will offer prayers of thanksgiving for the dedicated service and leadership of Miriam, Scott, and Kelli.

During the Annual Meeting Dan Droege and Doug McIver were confirmed to serve another term as parish wardens. Finally, Dan Droege, Doug McIver, Jeff Birch, and Kris Bonner were elected to serve as delegates to diocesan convention.

CONCERN 2019 Meeting Minutes and Summary

Many changes happened in 2019 at CONCERN most notably the sale of the Child Learning Center and bringing on a new Executive Director. What has not changed is continuing to provide much needed food and urgent financial support, distributing over 120,000 pounds of food and over \$12,000 in cash to people in desperate need. We also helped 45 people manage their Social Security benefits through the Payee Program. None of this would be possible without the 2,500 hours worked by our volunteers. We ended the year in the black for the first time in many years which is a good feeling, but we are not resting. We will always rely solely on the generous donations of money, food and time from many of you as well as St. Luke's, and I extend my heartfelt thanks for that. 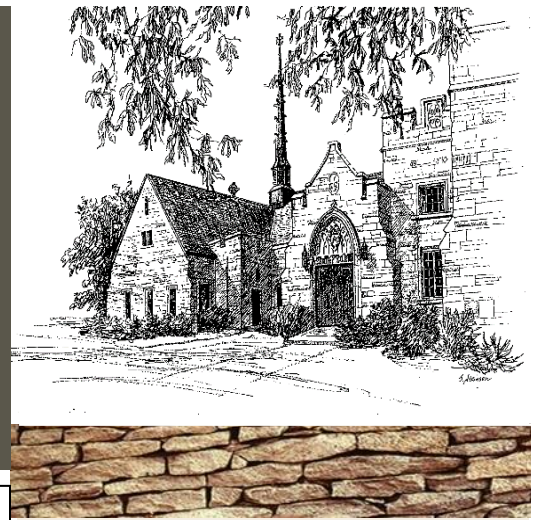
