



 - Training/School of Discipleship




Diocese of Oklahoma Congregational Vitality Assessment

- An online assessment tool
- Not a report card but a mirror
 - Qualitative survey of congregational leaders
- Purpose is to help self-identify areas of strength, areas of concern, and opportunities for growth
- Participants are completely anonymous



Format and Sample Questions


- 12 Sections with approximately 5-10 questions

 - "We regularly "get outside the building" to learn about our surrounding community




Next Steps

- I will check in twice after we start the survey to let you know how many people have taken it








