

### Walking the Mourner's Path is Stepping Up and Stepping Out This Fall

This week our facilitators began reaching out to local hospice agencies and mental health advocates in hopes of casting our net wide in order to form our next group for our fall offering here at St. Luke's. We know that in times of loss, finding a path toward healing can be challenging and this makes it even harder to take the first step. Would you be willing to help us get the word out? If yes, here is some background.

Walking the Mourner's Path at St. Luke's offers a unique and supportive way for individuals to navigate their grief. This program originated in the Episcopal Church and is now widely adopted by various denominations and communities seeking to provide comfort and understanding to those mourning a loved one.

Walking the Mourner's Path is an eight-week program designed to help participants through their grief journey with the support of trained facilitators and a small group of peers. Each session combines prayer, reflection, and discussion, creating a safe space for participants to share their experiences and emotions. The program emphasizes that grief is a personal journey, but it does not have to be traveled alone.

The core of the program lies in its structured approach, guiding participants through different stages of grief and healing. Topics range from understanding the nature of grief to finding ways to honor and remember the loved one who has passed. By fostering an environment of compassion and empathy, Walking the Mourner's Path encourages participants to explore their feelings, confront their pain, and ultimately find hope and renewal.

It has been reported that churches and communities that have implemented the program report significant positive impacts on participants. Many have found a renewed sense of peace and a deeper connection to their faith. Facilitators, such as those here, who have been previous

participants themselves, play a crucial role in providing guidance and support, drawing from their own experiences of loss and healing.

As grief is a universal experience, Walking the Mourner's Path extends beyond religious boundaries, offering solace to anyone seeking to navigate the complexities of mourning. While the program is unabashedly Christian, it also serves as a testament to the power of community and shared experiences in the journey toward healing.

My friends, this is a ministry that is truly "arms wide open." If you can pass the word along, I would be grateful.


